Terms and Conditions

- Volunteer registration forms are to be filled out annually for insurance purposes.
- As a volunteer, you may be requested to obtain a National Police Clearance or a Volunteer National Police Clearance, depending on the task/s allocated.
- AGE Volunteers of all ages are welcome. You must be over 18 years of age and have an RSA certificate to volunteer in the licenced areas of our festival. Under 18 volunteers must be accompanied by a volunteer parent or guardian.
- DRESS CODE Closed in shoes must be worn at all times whilst volunteering at our festival. This is for your own safety and strictly enforced. Volunteer shirts may be provided, but only to be worn when volunteering.
- BRIEFING The Volunteer Coordinator will contact you with a date and time for a briefing.
- ENTRY An armband will be issued when yo sign on for your first shift. These are non-transferable and if lost or broken, will not be replaced.
- ATTITUDE Volunteers are required to wear a happy smile and have a positive attitude at all times. If you have any concerns and/or complaints, please present them in writing to the Volunteer Coordinator.
- OHS The Country Music Club of Boyup Brook WA Inc. takes pride in observing high standards of Occuptaional Health and Safety throughout the festival. We endeavour to provide you with the safest working conditions possible. As a member of the volunteer team, we ask you to comply with all the safety equirements associated with your volunteer position and support the OHS procedures. Please follow the Volunteer Coordinators direction at all times.
- CONTRACT Volunteer contracts are applicable before, during and after the festival.
 - You must be available to work for a minimum of eight (8) hours during the festival period to qualify for a full weekend pass.
 - You will be notified of the shift you are rostered to work before the festival.
 - If you would like to volunteer for more hours or have an issue with the shift you're allocated, please contact the Volunteer Coordinator.
 - Pre and post festival volunteering is crucial to the success of our festival, so please consider one or both positions as an option.
 - NO SMOKING while wearing your volunteer shirt!
- DISMASSAL No volunteer will be dismissed until the volunteer has the opportunity to discuss the reasons for dismissal with the Volunteer Coordinator. Final decision will be made once there is consultation with at least two coordinators/committee members. Possible grounds for dismissal include, but are not limited to, the following;
 - Being under the influence of alcohol or drugs, before or during your shift.
 - Theft.
 - Insubordination, abuse or mistreatment of festivalgoers, volunteers or management.
 - Failure to abide by festival policies and procedures.
 - Failure to complete your shift as directed by the Volunteer Coordinator.
 - Disappearing during allocated tasks.
 - Failing to turn up for your allocated shift.
 - Smoking in the Music Park.
