The winning songwriter will receive \$2,000 and runner-up songwriter \$1,000. The winning song will be performed at the 2025 Boyup Brook Country Music Muster, and the songwriter does not need to be the performing artist on the track.

All songwriters are encouraged to participate and contribute their voices to this important conversation about drought and its impact on communities.

Entries close on Friday, 29 November 2024. Share your voice and help raise awareness through the power of music.

ENTRY CRITERIA

- Song must reflect the theme of drought, capturing the resilience, hardships, and hopes of those living in rural and regional areas of Western Australia.
- Participation is open to residents of rural and regional Western Australian ONLY.
- Open to songwriters of all ages.
- Songwriter/s do not need to perform the song themselves.
- One (1) song per entrant.
- The winner and/or their performing artist should be available to present their song at the 2025 Boyup Brook Country Music Muster.
- Songs to be submitted in MP3 format. Please do not send stream or video links.
- Submit lyrics in a WORD document.
- Submit photo of at least 2MB of songwriter/s, with no logos.
